


Interdisciplinary Refresher Course on 'Disaster Management'
Organized by the UGC Human Resource Development Centre, Mizoram University
From 6th November, 2018 to 26th November, 2018

UGC Human Resource Development Centre, Mizoram University organized an Interdisciplinary Refresher Course on 'Disaster Management' from 6th November, 2018 to 26th November, 2018 (21 Days). The Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Mizoram University, Prof. K.R. S. Sambasiva Rao inaugurated the programme on 6th November, 2018 at 11:00AM. About 40 faculty members from across different corners of India participated in the programme. It was a full time programme with 04 (four) sessions everyday starting from 10.00 am till 4.30 pm with a break of half an hour in between. It was mandatory for all participants to attend every session. Experts from different fields delivered classes, which were interactive in nature. The participants had to put attendance on daily basis before commencement of the classes and at the end of the classes. Feedback on each of the classes taken had also to be submitted on daily basis. On each Saturday assignments had to be submitted on given topic, including article review/ book review etc bearing relevance to the programme. Field surveys were also conducted in which all the participants were taken to a village named Sateek and randomly divided into groups comprising of 6-8 participants. On the basis of community interaction, observation and filed survey each group had to submit Field Survey Report and present the same as Seminar before all the participants on scheduled turn. Each participant had also to submit one assignment bearing relevance to her/his discipline of study and the broader theme of the programme under consideration. A Course Report comprising of the summary of the lectures covered during the course duration had also to be submitted by each participant on weekly basis. Class tests were also conducted time to time. Towards the end of the programme, the students had to appear before final written examination and on the basis of scores in the written examination, filed survey report, attendance, seminar etc the participants were awarded certificates.


