




Plantation – after the cleanliness drive, plantation of saplings was done inside the campus. Due to the lack of space inside the campus plantation was limited to three saplings only.

Republic Day was celebrated by the College in association with NSS, RSGC. The program was completed beautifully though there was not much gathering due to Covid-19 protocol.


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ACADEMIC AWARENESS & SPOT VISIT FOR FEASIBILITY OF ORGANIZING SPECIAL/SUMMER CAMP

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
CELEBRATION OF INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY (IWD) on 08.03.22



SURVEY DONE BY NSS, RSGC, Karimganj on the 21.03.2022

(at Dinesh Chandra Dev Smriti Children Home, Karnamudu, Dist-Karimganj)

The NSS Team, RSGC, Karimganj surveyed the said Children Home, which consists of 23 children on record available with the society. The Home is meant for only boys between 6-18 years of age. Sri. Sourob Kemprai, Superintendent, who is a caretaker of the Children Home, Sri. Santosh Kummar Dey (President, NGO) Sri. Debasish Chandra Dev as the Secretary I/C, Sangeeta Paul (Counsellor), Biswajit Kar (House Father, Pranat Das (Cook), Satya Prasanta Das (House Keeper), Ranjit Das (Helper), Binendo Paul (Night Guard).


The building occupied by them is on rental basis. However, 90% of the total expenditure incurred to run the Home is borne by State Child Protection Society, Assam and 10% share of the total expenditure incurred is borne by the Society which runs the Children Home. This children Home is monitored by District Child Protection Office, Karimganj and Child Welfare Committee, Karimganj.


Findings:

1. The Survey Team felt the necessity of giving them garments and sports materials for the distressed children.
2. Health of the children is in good condition.
3. Portable filtration drinking water facility is available.
4. One of the children (Dhruba Das) has passed out HSLC Examination recently.
5. It is found that the children felt homely, safe and secured.
6. Building consists of 8 rooms including kitchen. Adequate beds are available for the existing strength of children.
7. The Home is surrounded by boundary wall. But, the wall is made of temporary tin, which is not safe and secure for the children from the intruders.
8. Another new building is being under construction annexed to the old building.

The survey was undertaken by NSS Volunteers, RSGC under the guidance of Dr. Ashok Kr Das, Principsl, RSGC, Kxj, Mr. L Hmar, Program Officer, NSS and Sri S Kr Seal.

This summarized report is prepared based on the Survey Report submitted to P.O, NSS by Miss Juhelly Ferdaws Cannay, group leader, NSS on 22.03.22.

Rabir drasadan Girls' College, Karimganj (R S Girls' College, Karimganj) represented by its authorized signatory Dr Ashok Kr Das, Principal & Secretary, R S Girls' College, Karimganj, Dist-Karimganj, Assam (hereinafter called 2nd party) of ONE PART

AND

All India Society for Electronics and Computer Technology (AISECT) Skill Mission having its Head Office at Scope Campus, NH-12, Bhaironpur, near Misrod, Hosangabad Road, Bhopal-462047, Madhya Pradesh, represented by its Authorized Signatory Indranil Mukharjee Zonal Head AISECT SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRE, located at 2nd Floor, UDAYAN , 147 RG BARUAH ROAD GUWAHATI ASSAM 781005 (hereinafter called the 1st party) of the OTHER PART.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the agreement is effective from 16.11.2021 to till date to be specified as per discussion later on or at least to the point of time when the **latest batch of students** who are admitted with due permission from the **1st party** completed their course and get their certificates.

1. In pursuance to the notice/due approach **by the authorized representative from the 1st party**, the 2nd party has expressed the willingness to conduct a Three Month/Six-Month Certificate/Diploma Course in Computer Applications and other Skill Enhancement Courses abiding by the terms and conditions which have been mutually agreed upon.
2. The students who successfully completed the course will be awarded a **Certificate**, jointly **signed by the authorized signatories of the 1st party and 2nd party along with the Coordinator, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of R S Girls' College, Karimganj**, on clearance of the course fee by the student(s).
3. The course will be available to the **bona fide students** of the college. Admission format, mentioning the date of submission as devised by the 2nd party will be given for filling up form, either online or manually in the college website/college office on payment of the **Application Fee** as fixed by the 2nd party.
4. However, **the Committee for which as authorized by the** 2nd party will carry out the selection process either by means of **test examination or viva** and the names of the short listed candidates shall be displayed in the college website/notice board.
5. The 2nd party is **committed to provide** requisite infrastructure for the said course with the conditions that the 1st party shall judiciously use the resources with reasonable care whereas the 1st party shall **provide a course curriculum, contents and qualified and well trained teaching faculty as per UGC/AICTE norms along with study materials as required** for the said course. The 1st party shall provide a certified copy of course content to the Coordinator, IQAC.
6. The 1st party, while reserving its right to include or exclude any faculty, has to invariably ensure that the details of academic qualifications of all faculties must be as per Clause 6 above and such **details must be submitted to the Principal/the Coordinator, IQAC of the 2nd party for further verification**.
7. The answer scripts evaluation will be done by the competent faculty appointed by the 1st party in a transparent manner with a provision for the 2nd party to have a say in disputed matters.
8. **Expenditure relating to study materials and examination process** shall be borne by the 1st party out of the course fees.
9. The amount of **course fee will be determined by both the parties/signatories**. However, the fee structure may be **revised** by both the parties/signatories from time to time with due approval from the G.B of R S Girls' College (2nd party). The course fee shall be collected by the 2nd party from the students and after deduction of the said maintenance fee, the remaining amount/balance shall be given to the 1st party.
10. Classes will be taken on regular basis except on college holidays. The **Action plan** will be prepared by the 1st party in consultation with the Principal of the 2nd party and the same will be made available to the students. A copy of such time schedule of classes is to be submitted to the Coordinator, IQAC. Classes may be suspended by the Principal representing the 2nd party if such situation demands.

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11. Both the parties reserve the right to call off this agreement with a prior notice of 30 (thirty) working days in the wake of any eventuality, provided both the parties ensure that no student of any batch is left out with incomplete course, pending certificate and evaluation.
12. The number of batches and students to be trained have to be mutually agreed on and has to be notified by both the 1st party and the 2nd party.
13. The programme once initiated, should end within stipulated time and absence of students for an indefinite period or remain uninformed **for a long time** will not be entertained. The **decision of the 2nd party will be final**.
14. Both the parties will implement this agreement in letter and spirit.
